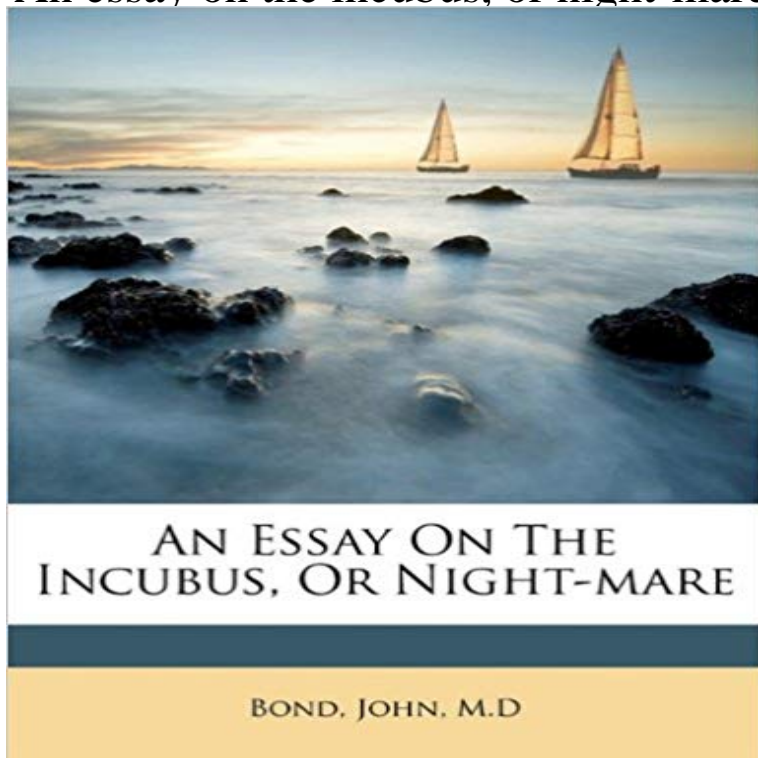


An essay on the incubus, or night-mare
