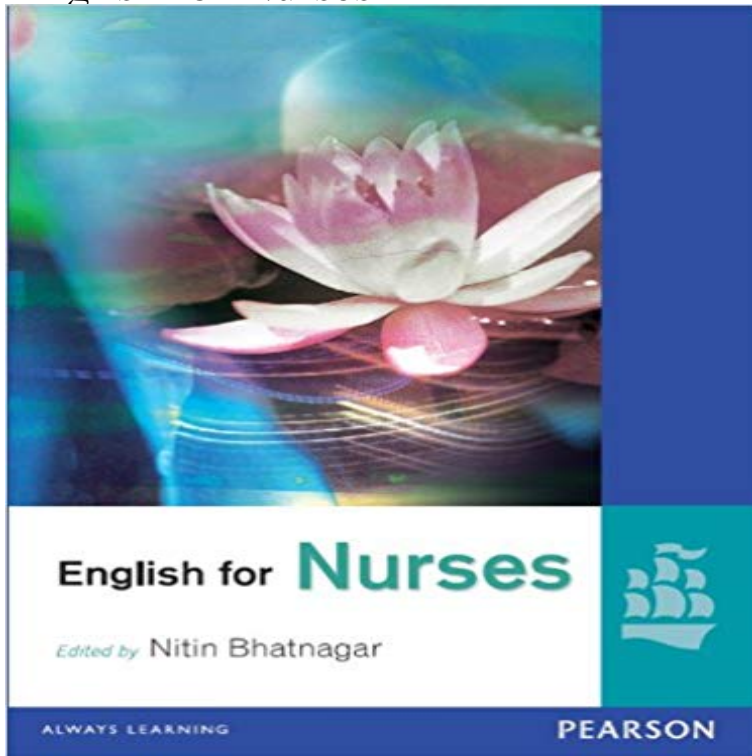


# English for Nurses
