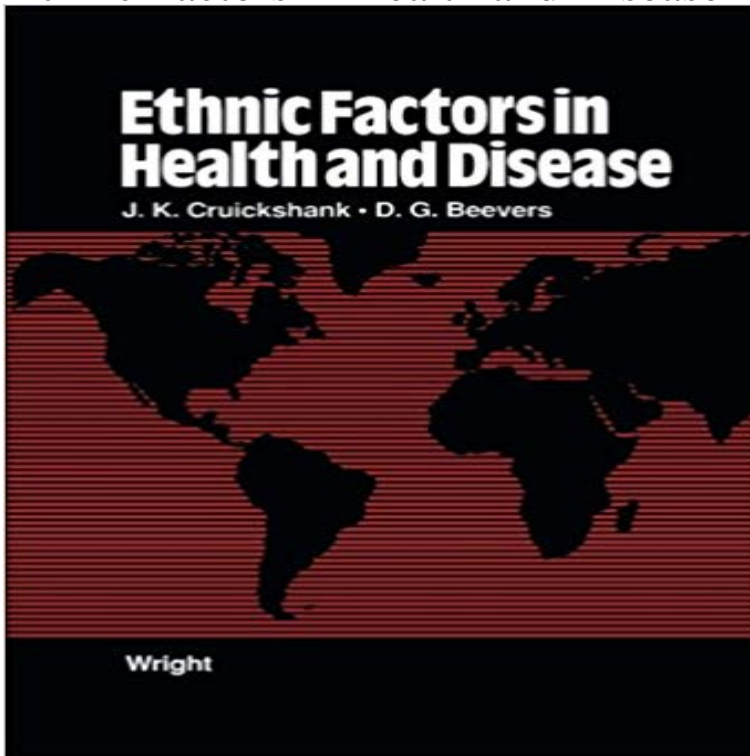


## Ethnic Factors in Health and Disease
