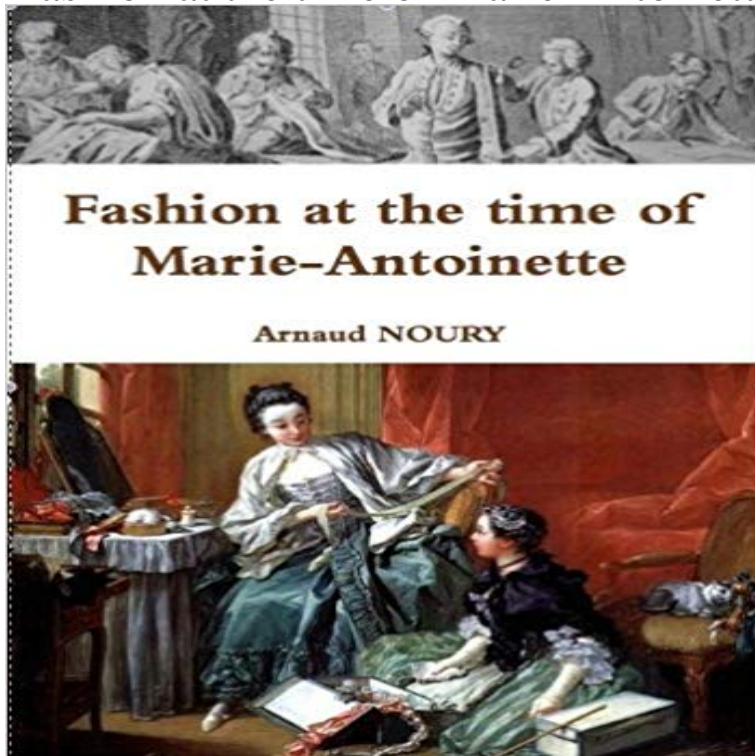


Fashion at the time of Marie-Antoinette
