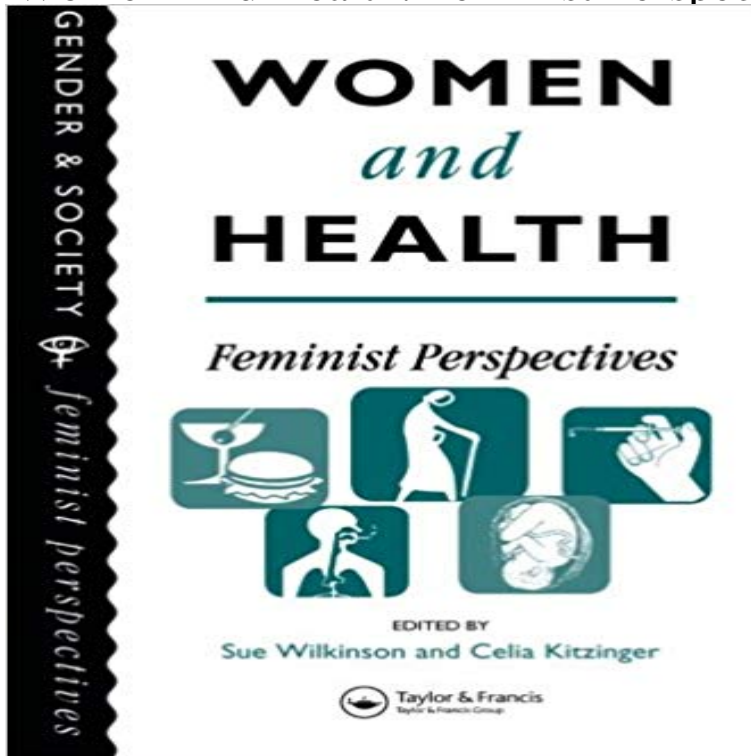


Women And Health: Feminist Perspectives (Gender & Society)
