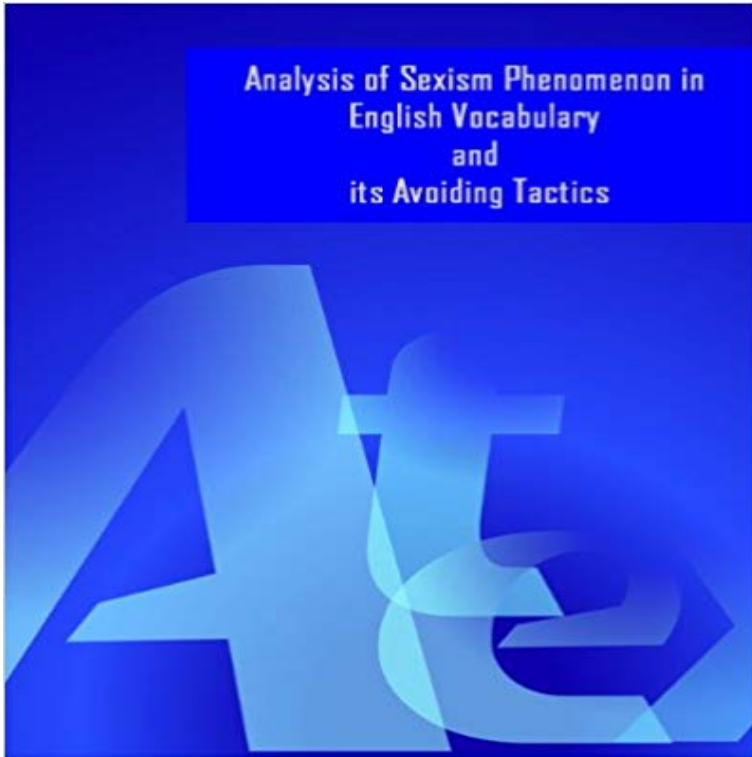


# Analysis of Sexism Phenomenon in English Vocabulary and its Avoiding Tactics
