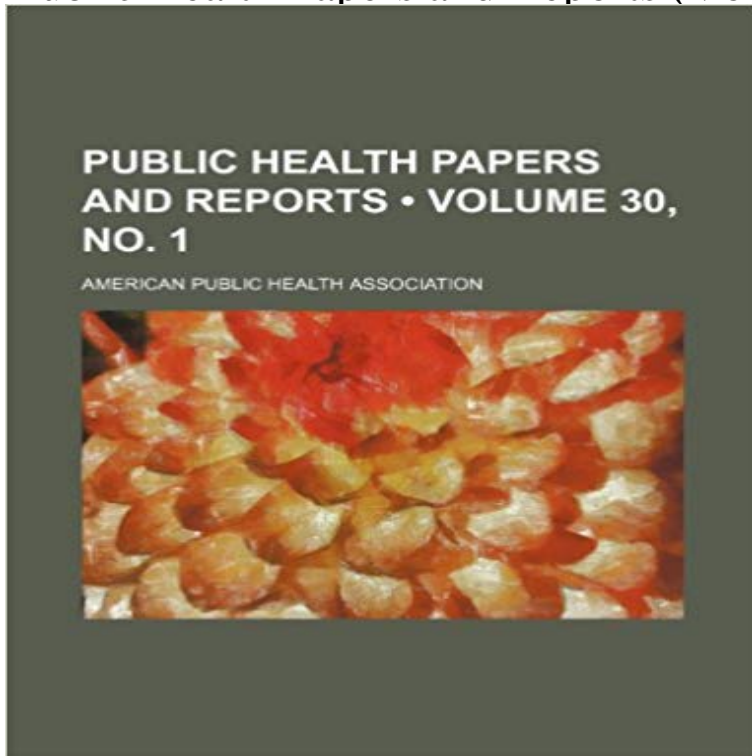

It is not my intention, in this paper, to bring up for discussion the health statistics of the city of Vera Cruz, but I simply desire to give you a knowledge of the present hygienic conditions of that port, and give you a true idea of what now appears so dark as well as of the hopes which we have for the future and the reasons on which we ground those hopes, that at no distant date this important port will be one of the healthiest that can be found. In support of the above proposition, I suppress the dry part of my studies and will only set forth the conclusions which I have reached in view of official statistics that I have had before me and of the notes taken from the practice of my fellow practitioners, as well as of myself, in our professional work. These show that in round numbers, out of every hundred deaths, the following are the causes: Tuberculosis 18 Yellow fever in normal periods 10 Malarial fevers 10 Other general diseases, considered under the Bertillon classification 5 Diseases of the digestive apparatus 18 Diseases of the respiratory organs 8 Diseases of the nervous system 2 Infantile diseases 25 Sundry causes 4 Total 100 If we reflect on the causes of this mortality, we find that tuberculous diseases bear more or less the same proportion to the total mortality as in other parts of the world. Although it is true that the deaths from yellow fever reach a high figure in some years, in others the number is very low and in still others there are no deaths whatever from it, for which reason the proportion that I have given is for periods

which I have called normal, as it is taken as an average, not considering times of epidemic nor those of total abs...
