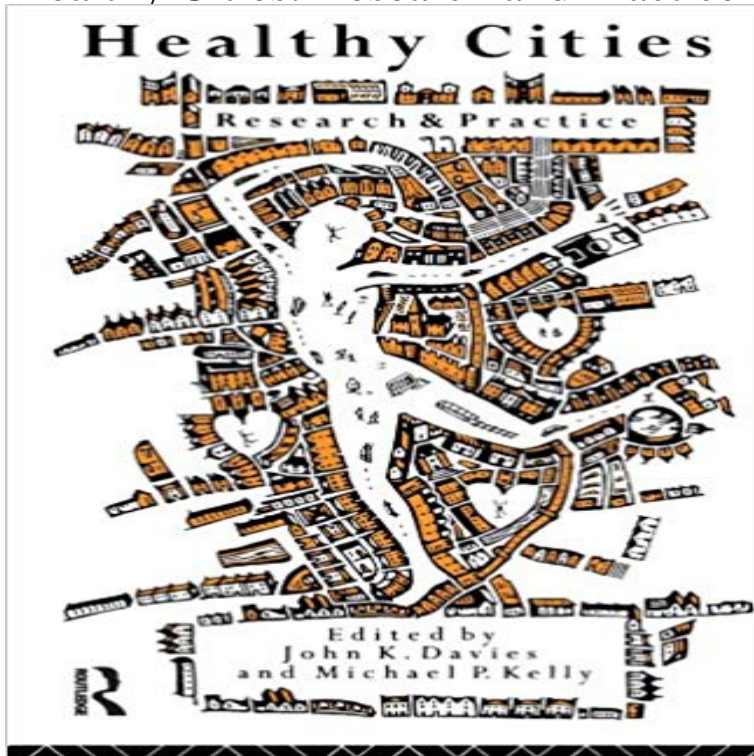


Healthy Cities: Research and Practice
