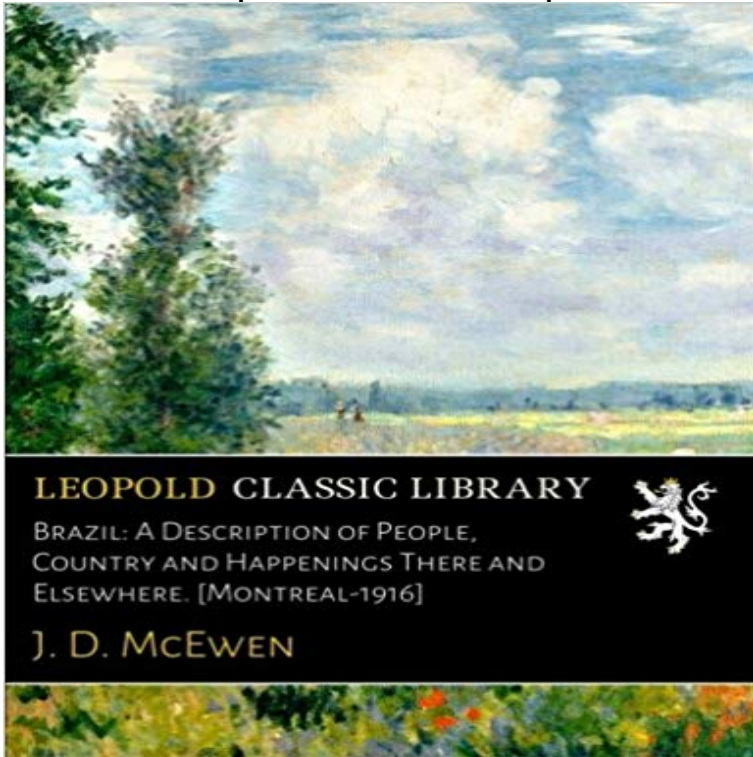


## Brazil: A Description of People, Country and Happenings There and Elsewhere. [Montreal-1916]
