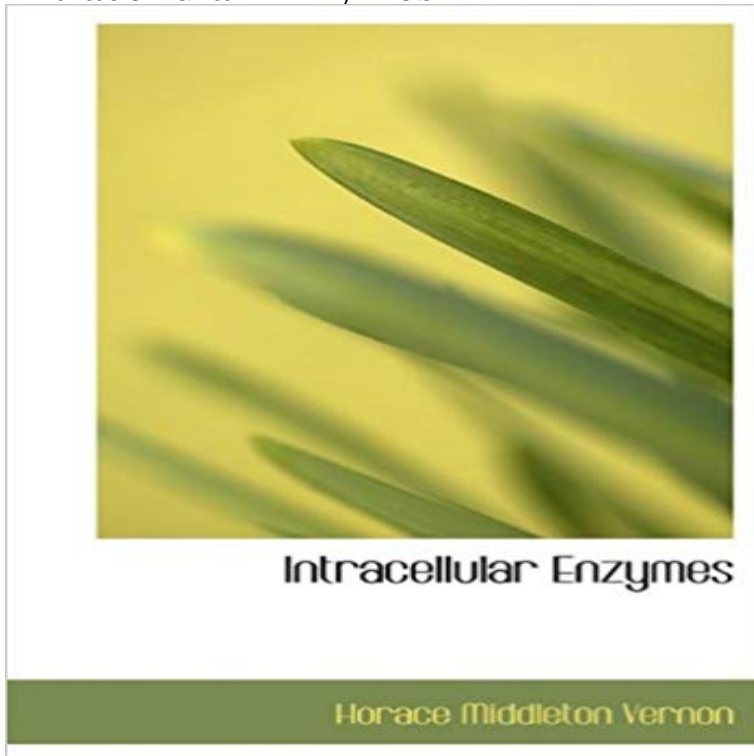


Intracellular Enzymes
