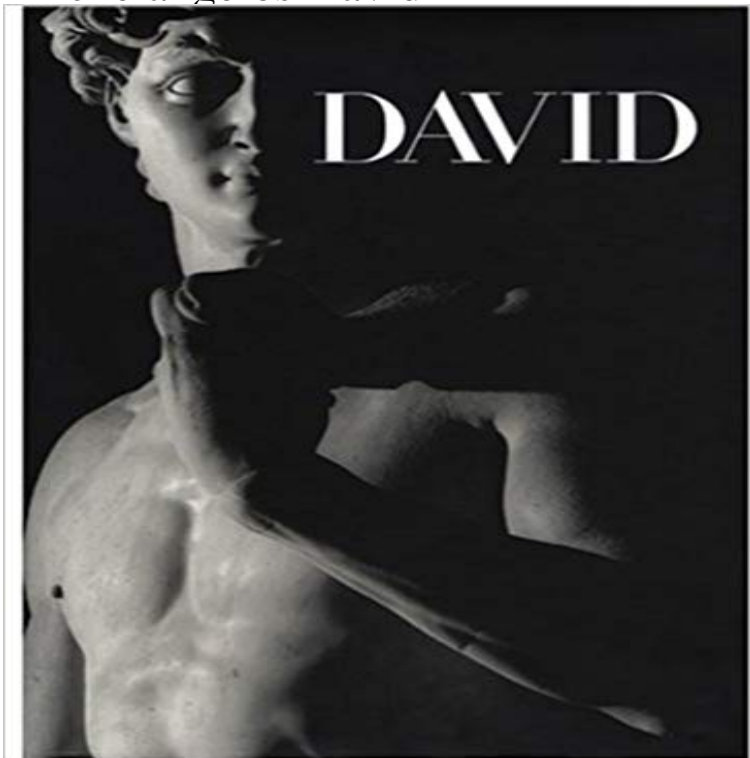


Michelangelos David
