

Stress is present in all professions; stress-related diseases, such as heart disease, anxiety, depression, and alcohol and drug use, are well documented. Yet surprisingly little has been written about the profession that has often to deal with the end results of stress - doctors. This book examines stress in general practitioners in the United Kingdom - the doctors in the front-line of medical care in a rapidly changing society. As well as being a thorough overview of stress in the medical profession in general, it includes the results of a unique survey of over 1800 GPs.
