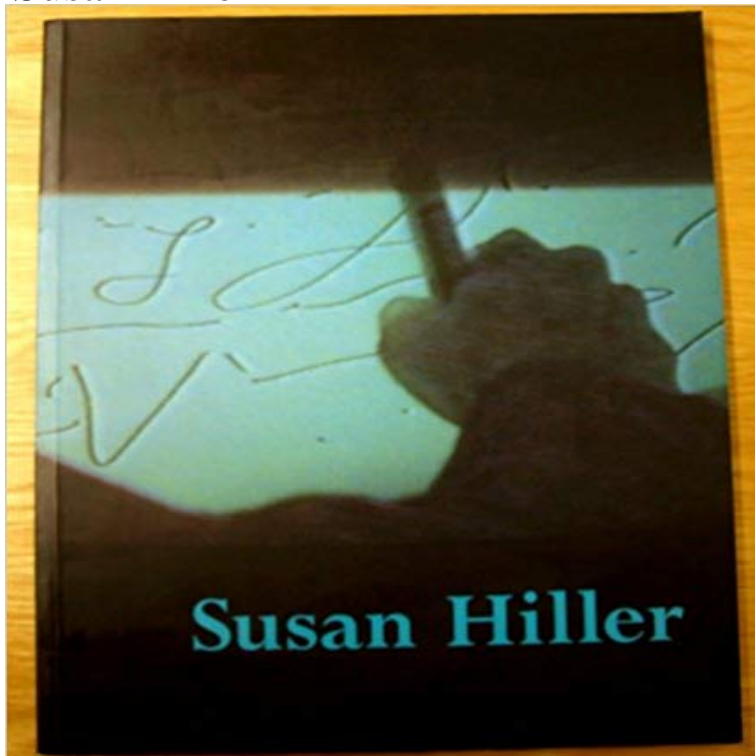


Susan Hiller



This work surveys the ways in which Susan Hiller has worked with ephemeral artefacts to produce art of emotional depth and cultural insight, for example her investigations into the hidden meanings of everyday objects such as popular postcards. The catalogue section, which features colour plates of works, has been written by Rebecca Dimling Cochran following access to the artists archives and is also illustrated with documentary photographs.
