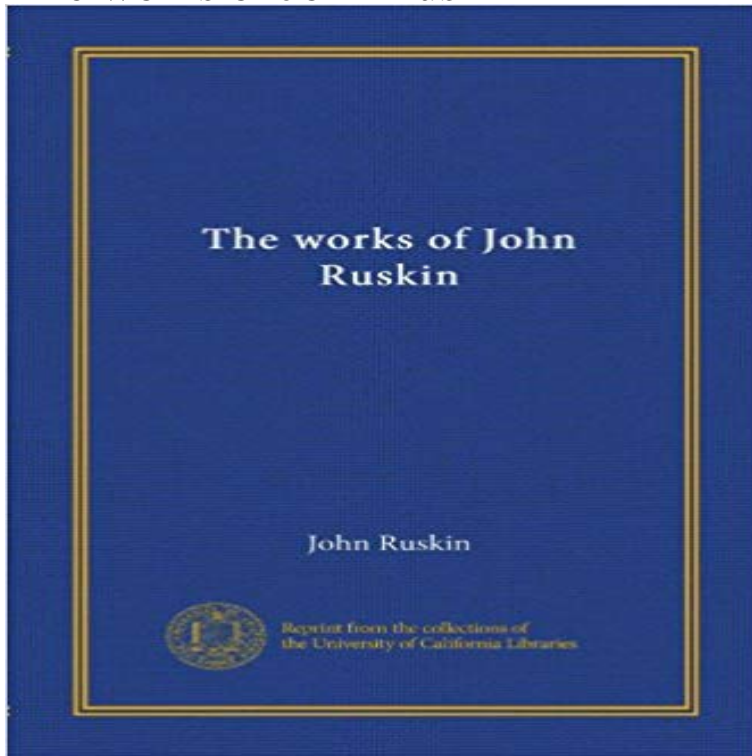


The works of John Ruskin
