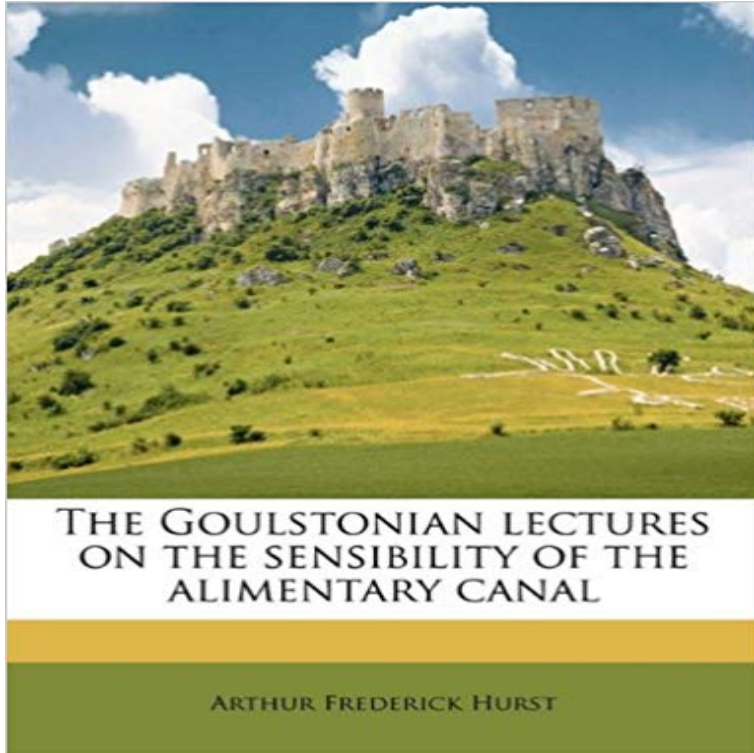


The Goulstonian lectures on the sensibility of the alimentary canal
