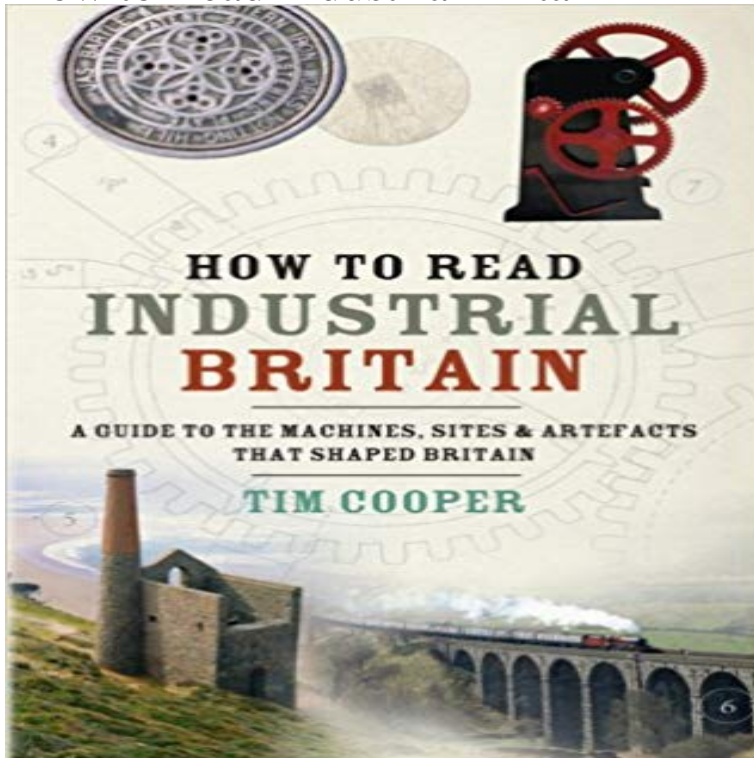


How to Read Industrial Britain
